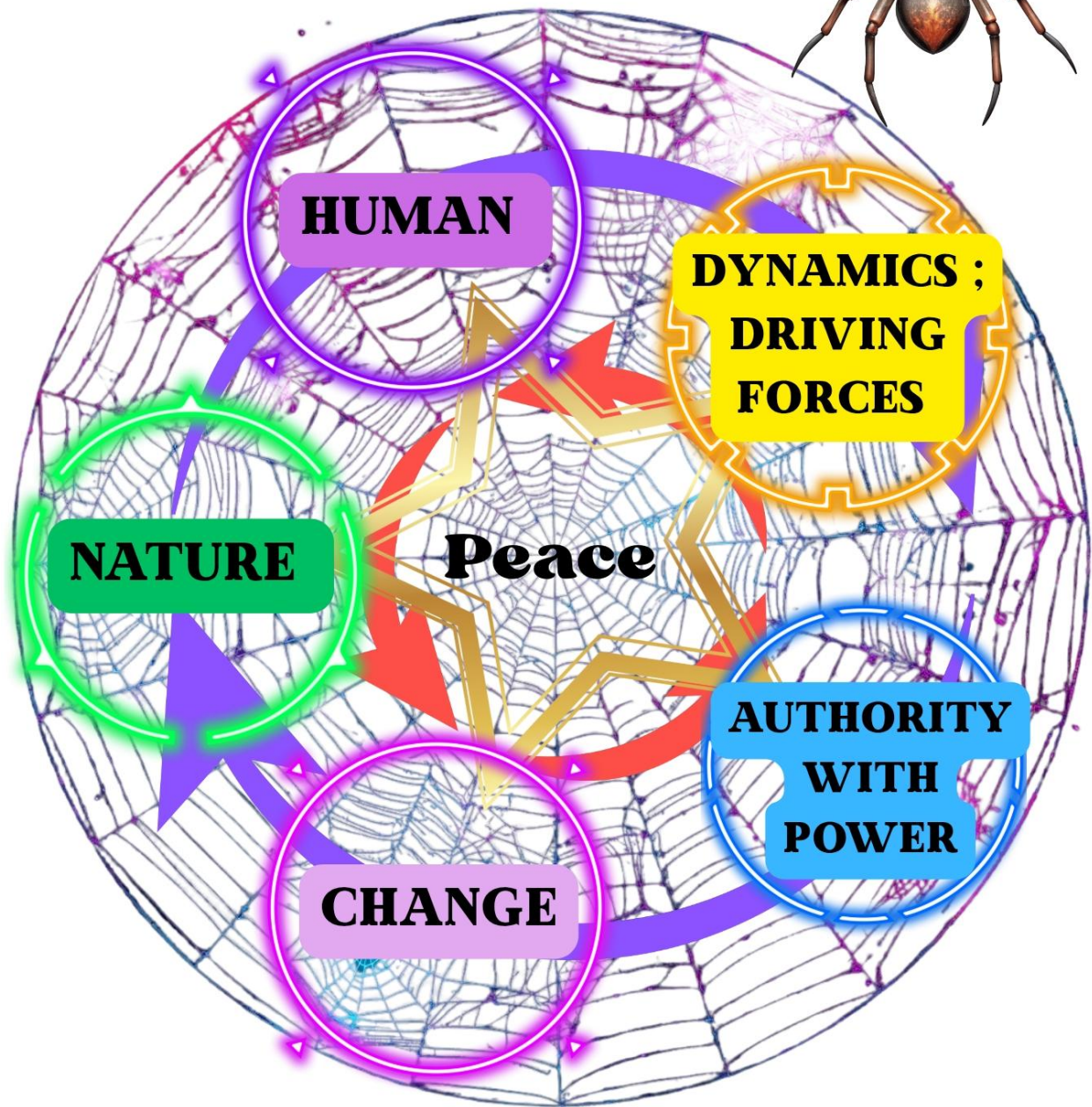


GLOBAL PEACE SYSTEM
